

B.I.T. DUO

(BACK IN TIME)

DANIELLE DI MAJO, SAX
MANUELA PASQUI, PIANO

Danielle and Manuela have been performing as a duo since 2019. From the very beginning, a special bond was formed through the sharing of artistic goals, which inspired their "musical exploration." With this ensemble, they have already recorded four albums for Filibusta Records in 2021, 2023, 2024, and 2025.



The duo B.I.T.'s first album, *Come Again*, was based on a new interpretation of material drawn from classical repertoires and original songs.

Their intention was to create a personal sound and lyricism while developing a shared musical language.

Their second album, *Equilibrismi*, an exclusive collection of original pieces, serves as fertile ground where the two instrumentalists deepen their melodic expressiveness and the art of dialectical interaction between two musical instruments. The result is a continuous and profound exploration, both in composition and improvisation.

In 2024, B.I.T. released *Puccini, My Love*, dedicated to Giacomo



Puccini on the centenary of his death. This album is a mix of pieces by the Italian composer and original compositions inspired by his works. The idea of blending jazz improvisation with Puccini's operatic music is a bold and creative experiment, offering a fresh perspective on the Maestro's compositions. Each song is reinterpreted with original arrangements by Manuela Pasqui, demonstrating how Puccini's music can be transformed and renewed through different styles and interpretations.

The album premiered to a sold-out audience at Casa del Jazz in Rome and was also taken on tour in the U.S. in May/June 2024:

- May 29 - Abramson Family Auditorium at NYU - Washington, D.C. (Italian Cultural Institute of Washington)
- May 30 - Fulton Street Collective - Chicago (Italian Cultural Institute of Chicago)
- June 2 - Bop Stop Club - Cleveland (Ohio)
- June 4 - Festa della Repubblica - Chicago
- June 7 - Artlitlab Jazz Festival - Madison (Wisconsin)

In November 2024, they performed four dates as part of the Moncalieri Jazz Festival. Their concert activity continues with upcoming dates in Cairo and a new U.S. tour in 2026.

In December 2024, they recorded their latest album, *R-Esistenze*: **R-Esistenze** follows the path of searching for a historical identity, where memory serves as a means to understand ourselves:

"With this project of original compositions, we have pushed forward in our exploration of a distinctive musical language. We were inspired by figures who, between 1920 and 1950, left an indelible mark on our country's history through political action, activism, and poetry—writers, poets such as Lalla Romano, Miriam Mafai, Joyce Lussu, or Eugenio Montale, but also ordinary people with a strong civic sense."
